From 20th to 22nd of Sept. in Valsabbia (Brescia, Italy) takes place the XXIII edition of Tra/montani Meetings BAGOLINO BECOMES THE INTERNATIONAL "CAPITAL" OF MOUNTAIN CULTURE

A three days Convention to go deeper into the forgotten word of the artists who developed the Alpine valleys and villages from the Middle Ages to the Modern Era.

The artists who developed the Alpine valleys and villages from the Middle Ages to the Modern Era are the main characters of the **2013 Conference of "Incontri Tra/montani".** The Tra/montani meetings born in 1990 from a reunion among cultural Associations of Valle Camonica and Valtrompia (Italy) in order to create a non-institutional network between groups settled into Alps (Italians, Swiss, Austrian and French). The aim of the network is to promote mutual knowledge, cooperation and sharing experiences and proposals. The 2013 Conference will be held in Bagolino, the "pearl" of Valsabbia, from 20th to 22nd of September. This edition is focusing on Stories, Places and Artwork widespread in a large area and it will be the occasion to create collaborations among different cultural associations. The main event during this three days is the Conference of 21st, in the Ecomuseo della Valle del Caffaro, with the most influential international scientists and experts.
